



Declaration of California Proposition 65

Proposition 65 is a California law officially known as the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, approved by California voters in 1986. The purpose of the Proposition 65 warning is to ensure that people are informed about exposure to such chemicals judged by the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

Contemporary Controls (CCSI) reviews suppliers' certifications, content declarations, and confidentially disclosed chemicals and materials information. Based on foregoing information, CCSI has determined to the best of its knowledge and belief that certain Contemporary Controls marketed products may contain one or more chemicals on the Prop 65 List. CCSI products are not intended to cause user exposure to any contained substances, nor are they intended to be released or discharged during normal product use. To our knowledge, CCSI products are within the "no significant risk" range, and not harmful when normally used. However, Contemporary Controls has elected to provide this Proposition 65 declaration on our website.
